

I've compiled a comparison list using several searches and VirusTotal entries. My first comparison is <http://amaz0n-sale-deals.com>, compared to <https://amazon.com>. Secondly, <http://pa1pal-login.com> versus <https://paypal.com>. Finally, I found <http://free-iphone-promo.com>, which is compared to <https://apple.com>. The "amazon sale deals" and the "pa1pal-login" sites use typosquatting to appear as the legitimate company name. All fake websites listed above use HTTP instead of HTTPS; subsequently, there is no certificate or data encryption. Each has a call to action prompting you to enter personal information designed to harvest user information. Some websites, such as pa1pal-login, can look very similar to the real site's login page with slight visual and operational differences.
